## Bachelor of Business Administration with a Major in Management

## The management major is designed to give students the basic knowledge, skills, and values of management that build on the foundation provided by

 the University Core Curriculum and that are required for professional careers in management. The program of study provides courses in key areas of management education: organization behavior and development, human resources management, information systems, operations management, and small business management. The program stresses the importance of critical thinking skills, diverse cultural perspectives, and ethical awareness.Management majors are able to gain relevant work experience through internships and the VSU Co-op Program.

## Selected Educational Outcomes

Management majors will

1. demonstrate knowledge of management concepts and processes and their applications in organizations;
2. plan, organize, lead, and control in a variety of organizations and cultures;
3. recognize and resolve managerial issues using quantitative and behavioral methods and interpersonal skills.

Educational outcomes are assessed by embedded test items in major courses, internship evaluations, and examination of projects.
