

International Studies (INTL)

INTL 5000. Foreign Exchange. 0 Hours.

A course for foreign students enrolled at VSU under official exchange agreements of the University.

INTL 5170. Topics in International/Intercultural Studies. 1-3 Hours.

Special topics in international studies include on-campus experiences, seminars, and workshops such as the National Model United Nations program and the spring courses offered in conjunction with the Focus lecture series each spring. May be repeated for credit.

INTL 5500. Study Abroad. 0-3 Hours.

Prerequisite: Acceptance to a VSU study abroad program. Courses for students studying abroad on VSU-approved programs. Students must have written approval from the Office of International Programs and relevant academic units to register for these courses. The number of credit hours granted is dependent on the nature of the program. Faculty supervisors in relevant departments will be responsible for assigning credit and reporting grades.

INTL 5501. Study Abroad. 0-3 Hours.

Prerequisite: Acceptance to a VSU study abroad program. Courses for students studying abroad on VSU-approved programs. Students must have written approval from the Office of International Programs and relevant academic units to register for these courses.
