RISE 1000. Re-Ignite Seminar for Academic Recovery. 0 Hours.

Prerequisites: Approved appeal of academic standing suspension or financial aid SAP appeal. Graded "Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory". A course supporting undergraduates with fewer than 90 credits allowed to persist through an approved suspension appeal. Students build academic recovery skills through weekly seminars, study hall attendance, and targeted assignments. Emphasis is placed on time management, study strategies, mindset, and effective use of campus resources to regain momentum.

RISE 2000. Re-Ignite Seminar for Academic Recovery. 0 Hours.

Prerequisite: Approved appeal of academic standing suspension or financial aid SAP. Graded "Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory". A course supporting undergraduates with 60+ earned credits allowed to persist through an approved suspension appeal. RISE 2000 supports persistence and successful transition to graduation. By focusing on advanced strategies (e.g., degree completion, financial literacy, and career readiness) while maintaining accountability through weekly seminars and study hall.
